- 1. Bob Thompson opened the meeting with prayer at 7:10.
- 2. <u>Community Demographic Study (Dave Larkin and Sandy Steele)</u>: Dave Larkin showed a map of the Tri-City area identifying the homes of our members that he has started developing. Several studies of the Tri-Cities have been identified. One 2010 survey indicated that Benton County, Washington, had the lowest church attendance of any county in the United States.
- 3. <u>RLC Historic Study (Jim Lachut and Bob Thompson):</u> Plan to talk to Debbie Stankovich to get some stats, to get pointed to archive information, and to obtain suggestions of people to interview.
- 4. <u>12 Keys Planning (Pastor Steve and Joel Sorensen)</u>: Will provide a report at the next meeting.
- 5. MOVE Assessment (Jenny Page and Dave Brandes):

  - b. Key points so far:
    - i. Cost: \$1500 for the initial survey with 2 and 4 year follow-ups.
    - ii. Survey Feedback: 40-page report with about 100 pages of supporting information.
    - iii. Seems to have good analysis tools and supporting materials.
    - iv. Need 100 members plus to participate to improve the statistical quality of the survey but will conduct a survey with a minimum of 30 participants. Bob Thompson reported that over 300 participated in the last survey that we conducted.
    - v. After November 10<sup>th</sup>, the next surveys are in January.
  - c. Questions from the team members:
    - i. Do we have churches that used the survey in the Pacific NW?
    - ii. Are there other surveys that should be evaluated?
    - iii. Is the popularity of this survey growing?
- 6. Other Discussion Points
  - a. <u>Retreat Center</u>. Further checking is needed but we think we have \$230K on the books for a Retreat Center. Concerns were expressed on being able to fund the annual operating cost of a retreat center.
  - b. <u>Financial Opportunity</u>. The cost of money is favorable for doing some capital project in 2013.
