- 3. Expanding Our Evangelism Efforts
- 4. Leveraging and Developing Our Spiritual Leaders
- 5. Continuing to Thank and Praise God in *Worship*
- 6. Improving and Leveraging Our *Resources* to Accomplish the Above Objectives

The objective statements should address RLC today, RLC in three to five years (what do we look like?), and the main steps to get there.
