## I Want You For the Harvest

From Pastor Steve

Jesus went through all the towns and villages, teaching in their synagogues, proclaiming the good news of the kingdom and healing every disease and sickness. When he saw the crowds, he had compassion on them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd. Then he said to his disciples, “The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field.”

I’m confident you’ve seen him! Uncle Sam with his pointing finger saying, “I Want You for U.S. Army.” Painted by James Montgomery Flagg in 1917, when the U.S. entered World War I, this very famous poster was used to recruit for the war. When I read the words of Jesus captured in Matthew 9 above, I think of this poster. Really, I imagine Jesus with his pointing finger saying, “I Want You for the Harvest.” I know it’s corny, but hey, are you surprised? You know me.

In this text, Jesus points out to the disciples the need for harvest workers. Having compassion on the many people with whom Jesus interacted, he saw their great need. Harassed, helpless, like sheep without a shepherd, Jesus saw them.

Truth be told, people have not changed much since the time of Jesus. We’re still harassed, helpless sheep without a shepherd. I’m sure this rings true. Unless you’ve been living under a rock, the evidence can’t be missed.

Furthermore, not only are people hurting and in need of a shepherd, but there also remains too few workers for the harvest. And things are moving in a downward trend. I Googled, “volunteerism down” and was surprised by the results. There are myriad articles with the same basic headline, “Fewer Americans are volunteering even as need grows.” “Volunteering in the U.S. is on the decline, reports say.” “American volunteerism continues to decline, studies find.” A decline in volunteers worries nonprofits.” And these from credible sources like, Fortune, U.S. News & World Report and NPR.

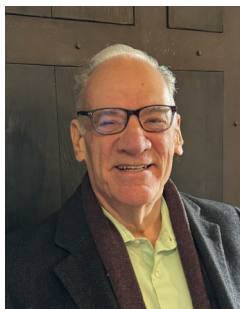
My point is this, if you are a disciple of Jesus, hear him say to you what he’s said to generations of disciples before, “I Want You for the Harvest.” Pray asking God to clearly reveal to you the 5 W’s: Who, What, When, Where and Why, and then get to work on the harvest of Christ!

“For me, success is not about the wins and losses. It’s about helping these young fellas be the best versions of themselves on and off the field.” This is a quote that comes from the great soccer coach, Ted Lasso. If you are talking with me, you will find that I have a great appreciation for Ted Lasso, a wonderfully created show that, while not explicitly Christian, does have a lot of Christian themes throughout.

In the show, Ted Lasso is an American football coach who goes over to England to coach a soccer team that the team owner has set up to fail. Throughout the series, Ted constantly showers everyone with love and positivity, in spite of all the challenges. While the team does not win every game and is far from perfect, we see each person grow and become a better version of themselves because of the relationships they are surrounded with.

One of these themes is that the goal of any relationship and life is to be the best version of ourselves, an idea that scripture supports but is often misunderstood within the capital C Church that exists today. Philippians 2:5 tells us that we must think and act like Christ Jesus, while 1 John 2:6 commands us to walk in the same way that Jesus walked if we are abiding in him, and Ephesians 5:1-2 directs all believers to be imitators of God.

While scripture instructs us to be like God, who is perfect, that seems unattainable as we are sinners living in a broken world. I know I am far from perfect, and the list is extensive. I have a good amount of extended vocabulary that makes me sound better fit on a Navy submarine than a church pew, I am not the most patient person, and that is simply the tip of the iceberg. Every day, all of us sin and fail to live up to a perfect imitation of God. And too often we are taught in church that we have to be perfect, or we are failing. I grew up in a church that told me if I had tattoos, I would go to hell (guess I didn’t follow that teaching). Others hear that some sins may be unforgivable. Others may feel they have to perform and appear like they have it all together.
