Reporting from the Mission Field

On July 1 Hans and Nancy Toffer visited Holy Jakob Church, the congregation in Estonia, on the island of Saaremaa. We were able to see the refurbishment of the prayer room and also the continuing work on the interior walls of the church sanctuary. The congregation is dedicated to returning the centuries old building back to its former beauty and usefulness for the surrounding countryside. It was wonderful to see old friends again. They were proud to show us the remodeling work that had taken place in the past two years.

The prayer room is inside the 12 foot thick walls which can be reached by climbing circular stairway. The chamber has been refurbished with new ceiling beams and new wooden flooring. All materials for the work came through the small, narrow windows. During the remodeling work they discovered an alternate access opening to the prayer room. The plan is to make this medieval style room available to modern day pilgrims just as it had been used in the past.

Word has spread about this facility and pilgrims from other European countries have signed up for days of meditation and prayer. We were impressed with the congregation's dedication and they were most appreciative of Richland Lutheran's support.

The walls behind the altar in the sanctuary were hidden behind huge plastic sheets to control the dust generated by the restoration work on the walls. Removal of the outer layer of plaster has revealed many pictures and other surprises including a doorway to nowhere.

After the tour, we adjourned to the congregation meeting rooms where we continued our discussion of the work at Holy Jakob Church and the relationship with Richland Lutheran Church. We discussed the possibility of greater interaction between Holy Jakob youth and Richland Lutheran Church via the use of Facebook or using e-mail communication. Other suggestions were exchanging addresses, youth visitations, and including youth interactions in our prayer life. They wondered if there was a possibility of youth from Richland Lutheran coming to Saaremaa for a visit next summer to be followed by youth from Saaremaa coming to Richland. Language would not be a barrier as young people today learn English.

While we were talking, a youth group from Finland was playing tag ball outside on the grass. The youth camp area makes use of the former home of the pastor and the former horse stables. With the financial help from Good Shepherd Lutheran Church and Richland Lutheran Church these buildings have been renovated to accommodate sleeping facilities for 60 youth. The youth camp is heavily used during the spring and summer months, especially by groups from Finland.

2009-2010 Confirmation Dates Set

A **Confirmation Orientation Meeting** for incoming sixth graders and their parents will be held on **Wednesday, September 2**, at 7 PM in the Prince of Peace fellowship area. At this time, we will present an overview of the confirmation program and discuss what participation involves. Parents and students of other grades who are new to the program are also encouraged to attend. The dates and themes of this year's Confirmation Retreats are:

- October 16-18, 2009 ("I Believe...in the Holy Spirit"),
- March 19-21, 2010 ("Prayer"), and
- May 14-16, 2010 ("God's Family, the Church")

Our Confirmation ministry is a four-year program of spiritual formation intended to prepare young people to make a mature commitment to the Lord. The middle school years (sixth-eighth grade) focus on the basic Christian teachings and developing spiritual disciplines such as prayer, Bible study, and reflection. In the ninth grade, the program focuses on special issues and congregational involvement. This year, the Rite of Confirmation will be celebrated on Pentecost Sunday, May 23, at the 11:00 AM service.

First Communion

In our church, baptized children may receive their first communion in the fifth grade. This requires parental permission as well as pastoral instruction. Pastor Martens will be conducting the First Communion Class on Sunday, September 20 at 12:15 PM. Lunch will be served first, and then instruction will begin.

During this class we cover the basic Lutheran teaching about Holy Communion as well as other information that will be helpful for participating meaningfully in the sacrament. We give each child the opportunity to taste an unconsecrated wafer and wine, so that they will be familiar with the taste before they commune. We also practice at the altar, so that they will be more comfortable with the actual procedure.

First Communion will be held on World Communion Sunday, October 4, 2009 at both Sunday morning services.

Council Statement

The ELCA Churchwide Assembly recently adopted a social statement entitled "Human Sexuality: Gift and Trust." In addition, four recommendations for Ministry Policies were adopted, which commit our denomination to finding ways to allow congregations to recognize "life-long, monogamous, same-gender relationships" and allow persons in such relationships "to serve as rostered leaders of this church."

As stated previously, the Richland Lutheran Congregation Council:

- affirms the traditional understanding of marriage as being a committed relationship between a man and a woman (Genesis 2:24-25; Matthew 19:4-6; and Mark 10:2-9);
- affirms the current moral "Visions and Expectations" for clergy and other rostered leaders; and affirms the Lutheran principle that official teaching must be based on Scripture alone, which is the "authoritative source and norm of our proclamation, faith, and life."

The Council wants the congregation to know that our call process for the Associate Pastor will be based upon traditional RLC views and procedures. In the near future, we will provide opportunities for RLC members to discuss these new ELCA policies. In the meantime, we intend to carry forward our mission and ministry, dealing with this recent ELCA vote as one of many facets of our ministry that will require prayer, deliberation, patience, and faith.

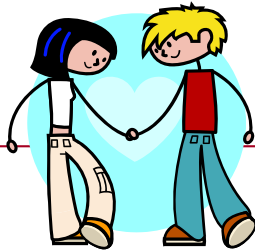

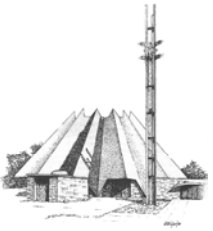
