

## *Share Your Faith During Lent*

We all know we should share our faith, but how do we do that in the course of daily life? We share some tips to help you do just that in the January issue of *The Preview*. Here are some more ideas as we move toward Easter.

### *In the course of daily life:*

- **Say "I will pray for you"** when someone shares a personal concern or difficulty with you.

### *At the office:*

- **Share what motivates you** to stand up for these values in such a way.

### *In times of struggle and pain:*

- **Share** a cassette tape of uplifting, **encouraging Christian music**.

### *In your neighborhood:*

- **Gather children in the neighborhood** for an afternoon Kid's Club. Share bible stories and tapes, craft activities, refreshments and positive play.

### *In your home and with your family:*

- **Monitor the television viewing** of your children; take time to explain why something might offend or please you.

### *At times of life passage and celebration:*

- Take time to **share how you feel** about the other person by committing your thoughts to writing.

### *At holiday and "holy day" times:*

- **Share verbally** why Christmas and Easter are times of celebration for you and your family.

### *Reflections:*

**Jesus' parting words to his followers were "Go, and make disciples..."** (Matthew 28: 19-20) It is clear that we are to be up front in our witness. We are not to sit back and wait for others to come to us. In our complicated and fast-paced world, people are not quick to discern "the hope that is within us." We must take the initiative by speaking and serving in the name of Jesus. We are to plant the seeds. The Holy Spirit is responsible for the growth and harvest.

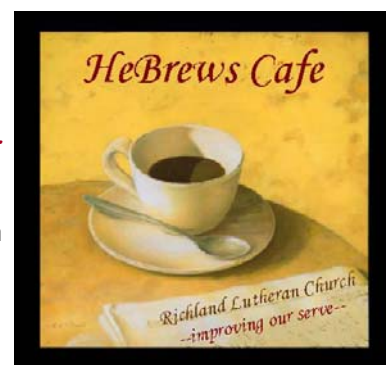

## Parish Nursing Notes

March is national nutrition month. The dictionary defines nutrition as the process of nourishing. Ephesians 5:29 says,

*“None of us hate our own bodies. We provide for them (nourish) and take good care of them, just as Christ does for the church, because we are each part of his body.”*

Let’s think for a few minutes about nutrition/nourishing, especially as many of us need to make our grocery dollars count for a good buy, but also that it provides what our bodies need. There is no magic vitamin or food. Eating a wide variety from all the food groups and keeping in mind the food pyramid is still the best way to take in what our bodies need for good health.

Perhaps you were taught, as I was, to clean your plate. In the past our society has thought of good food and plenty of it with second and third helpings as a sign of prosperity. Now we need to change our thinking. We know plates have gotten larger and we know for sure that servings, especially at restaurants have gotten larger. Maybe choosing a smaller plate can help us visualize how much food is needed. Here is a short portion guide:

- A medium apple or orange = a tennis ball
- A medium potato = a computer mouse
- A cup of fruit = a baseball
- 3 oz. of meat or fish = a deck of cards
- 1 oz. of cheese = four dice
- Pancake or waffle = a compact disc
- ¼ cups of nuts = a golf ball



Maybe I’ll start by sharing an order whenever I eat out. Your parish nurses are interested to know if you have nutrition tips to share that can be helpful to share so that we can all be wise in the way we nourish our bodies to do God’s work right here and now.

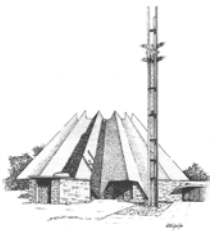
