## *Shrove Tuesday Pancake Dinner*

Shrove Tuesday is the day before Ash Wednesday. It is customary to eat pancakes on this day because for many Christians, Lent is the season of fasting. The pancake tradition started because for early Christians, fasting meant eating plainer foods — avoiding rich foods like eggs, milk, and sugar. Therefore, the day before Lent seemed the perfect time to use up all the foods that would not be eaten for the next forty days. A celebration with pancakes was the “last hurrah” before the observance of Lent began.

And did you know that Mardi Gras — which can be celebrated from Epiphany Sunday until Ash Wednesday — actually means “Fat Tuesday?”

So that explains the Tuesday part and the pancake part, but what about the “Shrove” part? “Shrove” is the past tense of the word “shrive” which referred to the English Christian practice of confessing one’s sins before Lent began so they would be forgiven. Of course, our faith includes being able to confess our sins to God anytime, so we can have fun with the tradition, anticipate Lent and what it might mean for us, and eat lots of pancakes!

Please plan to join us for a congregational pancake dinner on Tuesday, February 16, at 6:00 PM in the Prince of Peace fellowship area. We’ll have some table top games like tic-tac-toe, some carnival type games for kids, beads for everyone, and even a few surprises. O God, as you have done for us before."**

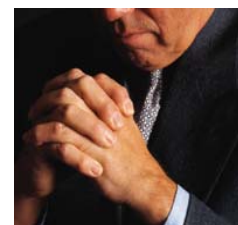

Therefore, in addition to encouraging your daily prayers, we welcome your participation in this *24-Hour Prayer Vigil for Richland Lutheran*.



The Prayer Vigil will be held in the chapel from 4:00 PM Friday, February 19, until 4:00 PM Saturday, February 20. Since I worked with children as a teacher for more than thirty years, I am always struck by similarities between parents and their children. We expect to see physical similarities but the behavior, language patterns, mannerisms, etc. that children pick up from their parents are there as well. We have seen this throughout our reading in GOD SIGHTINGS the first two weeks, where children inherit the "sins" of their parents. Isaac repeated the same behavior as Abraham when they moved into a new land and tried to pass off their wives as their sisters. I guess it "worked" for Abraham so Isaac uses the same ruse years later.



Since we know that similarities exist between parents and children, sometimes parents feel a great deal of responsibility, burden, or guilt at passing on "bad genes" or being a "role model" for their children. However, for

Christians - those of us who are baptized, who is the ultimate creator of genes and role model? God. God is our Father. We call ourselves, first and foremost, "children of God," or a "child of God." How wonderful it would be if we could take on the behavior, language patterns, mannerisms, etc., of God! We see those behaviors, language patterns, mannerisms, etc., reflected in Christ (in our New Testament reading). He is our role model.

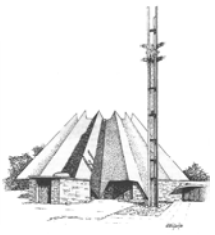

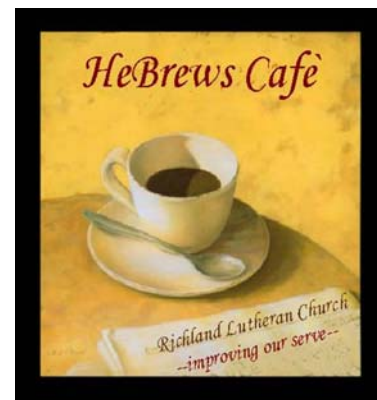
