# **RLC Foundation Annual Meeting Report – Ginnette Ernst, President**

Report Date: February 2022

<u>About RLC Foundation</u>: All members of Richland Lutheran Church are members of the Foundation. Voting members are those who have met the requirements for being voting members of Richland Lutheran Church.

<u>Planting Seeds of Ministry</u>: The RLC Foundation plants seeds of ministry which when nurtured by the Congregation and God willing grow into new and lasting ministries to the glory of God. A quick review of some of the seeds reveals how many lives are being touched by the work of this quiet behind the scenes partner of Richland Lutheran Church.

The RLC Foundation Board was able to fund the following ministry in 2021.

### Young Adult Ministry partnership with Flourish Mid-Columbia (2021)

In partnership with Flourish Mid-Columbia, the ministry seed is used to help develop and implement spiritual transformation ministry to, with and for Young Adults (18-29 years old) in Richland Lutheran, local congregations, and the community. Flourish was granted a second year of funding toward employment costs for Young Adult Minister, Mark Taylor. Please see their report attached.

### **Previous Seeds:**

- Young Adult Ministry partnership with Flourish Mid-Columbia (2020) Funding was provided to Flourish Mid Columbia for the start-up employment costs for a Young Adult Minister.
- Weekend School Meal Bags (2019) is a partnership with community schools. The community is appreciative of our participation by serving several children. The weekend food bags provide multiple children-friendly meals for the weekend ahead of them.
- **Reader Board Purchase** (2018) replaced an outdated (more than 50-year-old) reader board with a new current technology and highly visible reader board. Richland Lutheran Volunteers installed the board and provides communications to the neighborhood and those passing by. Almost immediately God used the opportunity to answer the prayer of a person going by who was praying for a Grief-Share Program in the Tri-Cities for her mother, to direct the hungry to the food bank, and to help mothers to find a Vacation Bible School. Reports continue to come to the office about thanks for the outreach to the community.
- **Grief Share** (2018) funding has allowed the RLC Health Ministry to launch grief-care programs. A workshop for those suffering from the loss of a loved one began In January 2019. Funds provided for the purchase of necessary materials needed for classes including a DVD pack, Leader's Guides, Participant Books and other grief support materials.
