Rally Day is a big day at RLC! Plan to join us to celebrate a new year of Sunday School and Christian Education!

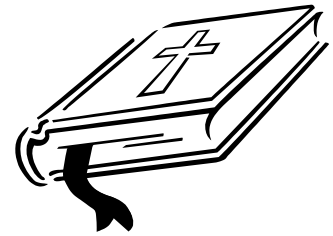
We go back to two services on September 12!

First Communion will be held on World Communion Sunday, October 3, at both services.

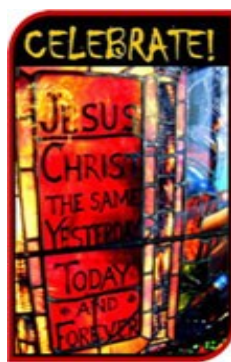

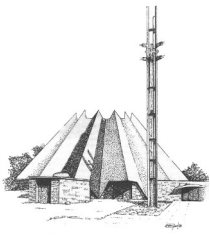

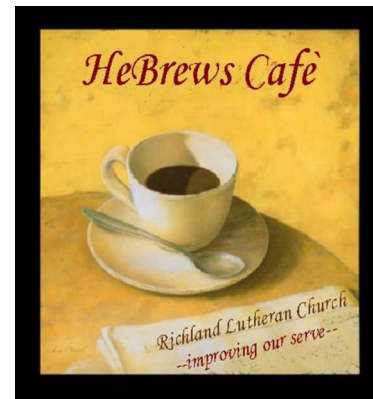
