## A Sermon Series on Prayer for Lent 2011

The Big Idea: Prayer was a very regular part of Jesus' life. It comes as no surprise then that Jesus prays diligently the last week of his life. The Gospels record four of these prayers caught at four different times; early in the week while in Jerusalem, in the upper room with the disciples at Passover, in the garden of Gethsemane and lastly in Golgotha as he dies on the cross. We, as his followers, can learn much from these prayers of Jesus. This Lenten sermon series is purposed to do just that.

## Bruce Higley Scholarship

A scholarship fund was established by Kathy Higley in memory of her husband, Bruce, who had a lifelong passion for and career in science and engineering. The scholarship is $\$ 1,000$ a year for as long as funds are available. Applicants must have achieved upper classman status, be enrolled as a full time student at an accredited university, and have declared a science-related major. The award is also available to graduate students pursuing science-related degrees. To apply for this grant, a letter indicating interest along with a three-hundred word essay setting forth educational goals and career plans must be submitted to the Minister of Christian Education who coordinates selection of recipients with the Scholarship Selection Ministry Team. Recipients of this scholarship must be members of Richland Lutheran Church.


## International Sunday School - The Importance of Letters

As a child's sponsor, we have such a wonderful opportunity to personally touch the life of the child we sponsor. Financially, we are giving them opportunities for better nutrition, medical care, school, clothing, and so much more. But, did you know that there is something more these children look forward to when they visit their project classrooms?

Mail day. Imagine being one of those children, sitting in class, waiting for the mail to be handed out. Imagine the thrill of hearing your name called, of being handed a letter from your sponsor. Imagine opening that letter and reading the words of someone who cares about you from far away, someone who wants to share Jesus with you, someone who wants to encourage you, love you, and be your friend.

As a sponsor, it is just as exciting to open your mailbox and find that envelope that says "Message from your sponsored child." Have you received your first letter? It can take some time, so be patient if you haven't heard from him or her just yet. How exciting, though, to see their words to you! Maybe they wrote it themselves in their little child penmanship. Or maybe it was written for them by their tutor. Either way, you should see the letter written in their own language, as well as translated into English.

Here are some excerpts from a few first letters:
Kathy Baumgarten's child writes: "Thank you very much for being willing to be my parent. I want to know about you. Pray for me so that God makes me a big person."
Carol Romsos’ girl writes: "I always pray for Carol Romsos. I want to know: what is Carol Romsos' job? Pray that I become a smart child, faithful to God, and moreover obedient to my parents."

Have you written to your child lately? Please, take some time to do so. Many of them are so excited to build a relationship with you. All it takes is a little time to make a big difference in the life of a child.
