Holy Week

Holy Week worship services provide an opportunity for spiritual growth and Christian education. Each of the services has special significance for Christians, and we urge you and your family to attend them all.

Maundy Thursday Worship

April 21 — 10:00 AM & 7:00 PM Communion Service

Maundy Thursday is considered the anniversary of the institution of the Eucharist by Jesus at the Last Supper. In some churches, Jesus' washing of the disciples' feet is symbolically reenacted.

Good Friday Worship

April 22 — Noon and 7:00 PM

Good Friday commemorates the crucifixion of Jesus at Calvary. It is a holy and somber day with special services and readings from the Gospel giving accounts of the events leading up to the crucifixion. Worshipers leave a dark sanctuary, grief-stricken, and silent.

Easter Vigil

April 23 — 7:00 PM Communion Service

Easter Eve is the day before Easter and is the seventh and last day of Holy Week. The **Easter Vigil** is celebrated after dusk on Saturday, marking the official start of the Easter season. The ceremonial lighting of the Paschal candle is one of the most solemn moments of the Easter Vigil. This is a representation of the risen Christ, whose light dispelled the darkness (death).

Outreach Tip-o-the-Month

This one is easy, wear your name badge. That's right, wearing your name badge helps us outreach. You ask how? Well, thanks for asking. There are several ways. First, it helps us identify those who are new to our congregation. When you wear your name badge it easily identifies you as someone who has been around a while. This makes it easier to tell who's new to our congregation so we might reach out to them more purposefully. Second, it helps those new to the congregation get to know you more quickly. Names help when you're trying to fit into a new group. By wearing your name badge you're telling new folks you'd like them to get to know you and you'd like to get to know them.

Third, when someone uses your name it makes them feel more welcome and comfortable. People get nervous when they have to address someone they don't know. If, however, you are wearing your name badge, the new person feels more at ease because they already know something about you. Fourth, it has the power to introduce without saying a word. People feel more comfortable when they are introduced to someone new. Wearing your name badge gives you an immediate non-verbal introduction.

Last, it only takes an extra 45.48 seconds (Slight variations may occur depending on stride length, cadence, people interference, recent coffee intake, purse size, shoe style, and other factors. Test performed by professional walker on a closed course.) to walk to your box, put on your badge and return to the narthex. So, begin your outreach ministry now by taking this easy step, wear your name badge.


