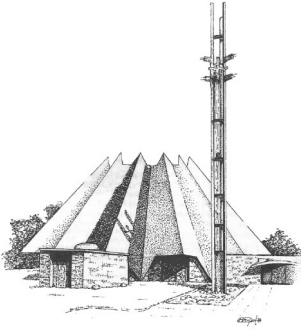

Our second trip was May 19 to May 22 to Riverside St. Park in Spokane. In June (23-26) we will go to Timberlake Campground & RV Park, July (23-30) will be our weeklong trip to Netarts Bay, on the Oregon coast, and in August (25-28) we will be going to Mt. Hood RV Village.

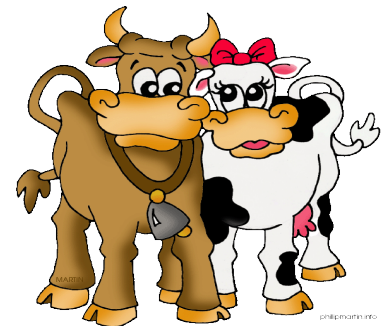

Vacation Bible School Adult Class “Being and Building

PARENTS, do something different and meaningful for VBS this year! Instead of simply dropping off the kids and enjoying a night off (which is certainly a temptation, we know all too well as fathers ourselves) join Corey and me (Pastor Steve) as we look at five spiritual disciplines all parents need to practice and pass down to their kids. Bible study, prayer, worship, service, and stewardship are the foundations of a solid faith in Christ and necessary elements to pass down your faith. This doesn't just happen and for too long now we've been abdicating our responsibility as parents to the church. It's time to take back what is ours and learn how to hand our faith down to our children, to disciple them, to set an example, to get back to the basics, to do the difficult work of raising up Christian kids. 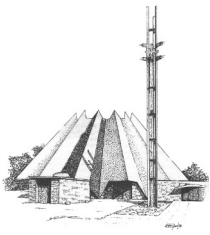

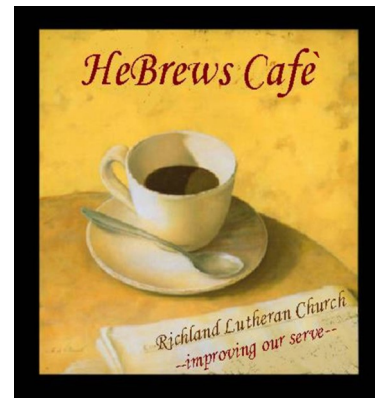
