Ephesians 4:16

The Apostle Paul uses the analogy of the human body to describe the Christian church. In First Corinthians Paul writes, "Just as a body, though one, has many parts, but all its many parts form one body, so it is with Christ. For we were all baptized by one Spirit so as to form one body whether Jews or Gentiles, slave or free—and we were all given the one Spirit to drink... Now you are the body of Christ, and each one of you is a part of it." For many years now this local body of Christ, Richland Lutheran Church, has been doing ministry together through ministry teams. We recognize we need one another to accomplish our vision and mission as Christ followers making disciples who worship, grow, serve and steward.

#### Read the Bible 2018

We are now in the books of Judges and Luke. Some of the most interesting, complicated, heart breaking, and fierce people of the Old Testament are found in the book of Judges. The Judges preceded the time of the Kings in Israel and they were quite the cast. Judges like Samson, the man with hair power; Deborah, the fearless judge whom men admired and feared; Jephthah, the judge who teaches us to be careful of the promises we make; Ehud who delivers quite the special message to King Eglon. Unfortunately, Judges also records the total failure of Israel to remain true to God, and sets the stage for the era of the kings which we will explore in the books of 1 and 2 Samuel. What happens when Israel wants to be like everyone else and have a human king? Well, it's not pretty, but it does lead to the rise of King David, who is an ancestor of Christ.

Thankfully, we also get a daily dose of the gospel of Luke. Get it? Daily dose? Luke was a physician. Now that you're done laughing, let's continue. Luke was not one of the original disciples of Jesus, but took it upon himself to write an accurate account of the life of Jesus. Luke accompanied Paul during some of Paul's mission trips and also wrote the book of Acts.

If you've fallen behind, or just want to join in, by all means, jump right in. We have several groups that are discussing this together and it doesn't matter if you're a Bible scholar or have never read any of the Bible-all are welcome! And remember, always be on the lookout for the foreshadowing of Jesus even in the Old Testament. Blessings on your reading!

# President's Corner - Council Updates

Dave Larkin, Council President Pastor Steve's Sabbatical - We have more exciting news to share on plans for Pastor Steve's Sabbatical this summer. As I told you last month, Pastor Corey will be filling in as the Interim Lead Pastor and he is looking forward to providing more sermons. As I write this we just received news that Pastor Karen Gardner has agreed to fill the Interim Associate Pastor position during the Sabbatical. Pastor Gardner left us for Oklahoma four years ago but still knows many members of the congregation. Her primary role will be visitation, for which she has a passion. It will be wonderful to have Karen back again.

**Benevolences** – Council just approved the Benevolences for the first quarter of 2018 and I thought you would like to know how your money is being used. A total of \$45,189 was approved including LCMC District -\$10,105.25, LCMC National \$15,000, EEMN - \$4,000, Lutheran World Relief - \$1,000, World Mission Prayer League (General Fund) \$1,084.20, Voice of the Martyrs - \$2,000, Mafraq Sanatorium -\$6,000, Wycliffe Bible Translators -\$1,000, Open Doors - \$1,000, Compassion International - \$1,000, China Connect - \$1,000, World Relief -\$1,000, and Tartu Academy of Theology (Estonia) - \$1,000.

Electronic Message Board - As I mentioned last month, Pam Hedges and Lois Harrold have been looking into installing an electronic Message Board on the corner of our property to better inform our neighbors and others of our events and worship services. The Richland Lutheran Church Foundation has generously approved a grant of up to \$45,000 toward the approximate cost of \$50,000 for this project. Council will be covering the rest. Reports from other churches were enthusiastic on the benefits of electronic signs and mentioned visitors to their services who came specifically because of the signs.

Council Seeks Your Input — While the Council always wants to hear from the congregation one of RLC's policies specifically requires that we formally seek input at least annually. This is an especially great time for you to provide us with your desires, concerns and expectations as we will soon begin the annual process of revising our Long Range Plan and developing a Ministry Plan and budget for 2019 for your consideration in October. Mark your calendar and plan to join us for a community workday. We will be doing some trail maintenance on Badger Flats Trail at Trailhead Park, 325 Queensgate.



# Men's Spring Retreat - Saturday, April 21

Following a reverent and prayerful Lenten season and the glorious Resurrection celebration Easter Sunday, all Richland Lutheran men and their friends are invited to the annual spring retreat to be held Saturday, April 21 in the Prince of Peace fellowship hall.

Pastor David Hogan will present "Temple Talk and Table Talk" as our retreat master along with Pastor Steve's contributions that day, which begins with a continental breakfast at 8:30 AM, and the first session at 9. Two lessons will be in the morning with a break followed by lunch at noon and a concluding lesson in the afternoon dismissing about 2:30 p.m.

Pastor Hogan notes we often hear "Temple Talks" included in our Worship service, but if we turn it around and consider what the Temple was and is from Scripture what can we learn? "Don't you know that you yourselves are God's temple and God's Spirit dwells in your midst?" (1 Cor 3:16) In these verses, Paul reminds the church of the Holy dignity of the God's temple calling. Pastor Hogan will unpack Scripture as it relates to Temple talk and how it impacts our walk "Doing Life Together" and "Making Disciples" in the Kingdom.

The time-honored Lutheran tradition called---Table Talk---comes from Martin Luther's words recorded in many volumes by students and guests from discussions with Luther and his wife Kathie at the Black Cloister in Wittenberg. In later years Luther's edited notes of these Table Talks revealed momentous "breakthroughs" in his spiritual life. Martin felt sinful most of his life and that God's righteousness punished sinners like him until he had an epiphany about Romans 1:17. The Table Talks version of this revelation was "he who though faith is righteous shall live." Engaging in a RLC version of Table Talks we can consider what we've heard and learned and discus how WE may individually and/or as a group make these lessons and truths action items in our family, our church and our community while remembering this year's focus of "Making Disciples."

We encourage RLC's men to join us for this educational and entertaining event as well good food and a great time of fellowship with the men of our church and your friends who wish to attend. No charge for the day's event, a good will offering will assist for the food and snacks for the day.
