## Do Lent for Others

### From Pastor Steve, Lead Pastor



**13** *<sup>1</sup>If I speak in the tongues of men or of angels, but do not have love, I am only a resounding gong or a clanging cymbal. <sup>2</sup>If I have the gift of prophecy and can fathom all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have a faith that can move mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing. <sup>3</sup>If I give all I possess to the poor and give over my body to hardship that I may boast, but do not have love, I gain nothing.*

1 Corinthians 13:1-4

John Chrysostom, Bishop of Constantinople in the late fourth century and an early church father said, “No act of virtue can be great if it is not followed by advantage for others. So, no matter how much time you spend fasting, no matter how much you sleep on a hard floor and eat ashes and sigh continually, if you do no good to others, you do nothing great.”

This is a great quote to remember what we’re doing during Lent must have implications for those around us. Many of us use the liturgical season of Lent to contemplate life and meditate more fully on our spiritual lives. To aid this endeavor, some of us practice spiritual disciplines and/or gifts like, fasting, solitude, stewardship, faith, prayer more fervently. However, as Bish-

op Chrysostom points out, if we do these things purely for ourselves, we miss the point of them entirely.

I can’t help but think that Chrysostom had the thirteenth chapter of the first letter to the Corinthians in mind here. There, the Apostle Paul reminds the church that if they practice tongues, prophecy, faith, and stewardship without love of the other, they “gain nothing.” Chrysostom says the same about fasting and other ascetic practices if done without giving advantage to others, “you do nothing great.”

As you do Lent this season, however you do it, I encourage you to think how what you’re doing can be used to the advantage and love of others. As you fast, ask God to speak clearly about how you can feed the hungry. As you pray from the comfort of your home, ask God to speak clearly about how you can house the homeless. As you worship with your church family, ask God to speak clearly about how you can become family to the alone. As you read Scripture in your warm jacket, ask God to speak clearly about how you can clothe the naked.

I am confident God has something for you this Lenten season to love and

bless others. Practicing spiritual disciplines, habits or gifts without love and seeking the advantage of others truly ends up being nothing. So make something of doing Lent this year. Listen to God speak to you about how you might bless the other.

## It's a DMin Program, Not a Demon Program

### From Pastor Corey, Associate Pastor



Ah, yes, that is the favorite joke about the Doctor of Ministry program I am currently working on. As many of you know, Pastor Steve is in the final stage of his program as he is working hard on his dissertation. I am in my first year, and it is truly fantastic. Pastor Steve's focus is on spiritual formation, while mine is apologetics. No, I'm not being trained to apologize for everything. Apologetics is simply defending the faith. I began this program last August because I feel it will help my brothers and sisters in Christ know Jesus and help them share this amazing faith. Here is a bit about what I've been studying...

Last semester my cohort ventured through the book *A Secular Age* by Canadian philosopher, Charles Taylor, which traces how society has become a secular stronghold unlike any other time in the last 500 years. That was 800+ pages of pretty intense philosophy! As a result of this class, I wrote a paper based on interviews I conducted with several members of RLC who are involved in science and engineering. The tentative plan as I type this is to present this work at a Flourish Mid-Columbia

faith and science gathering in late April. (Flourish Mid-Columbia is an organization that works to integrate faith, work, and everyday living)

We are now reading several books that deal with models of engaging our world. Although at times the reading can be a bit... tedious, for example from the book *Philosophical Fragments* by Kierkegaard under the pseudonym Johannes Climacus: "...A person cannot possibly seek what he knows, and, just as impossibly, he cannot seek what he does not know, for what he knows he cannot seek, since he knows it, and what he does not know he cannot seek, because, after all, he does not even know what he is supposed to seek." Actually, it's pretty fun stuff.

What has been fascinating is the very different approach to apologetics that this program is leading towards. Rather than "knowing all the facts", it is focused more heavily on personal relationships that are built on not only our verbal proclamation (recognizing that we are not experts-that's thanks to reading Kierkegaard), but having the world ob-

serve our lives to see if the truth of Christ really makes a difference. It has challenged my view on what it means to be a follower of Christ and how to share my faith in this complicated society.

If you would like to know more about my studies be warned...I like to talk about it, and hopefully, I can pass this on to my Christian brothers and sisters. Soli Deo Gloria!

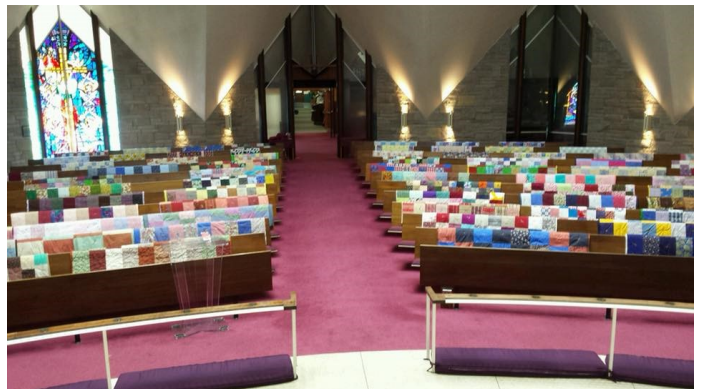

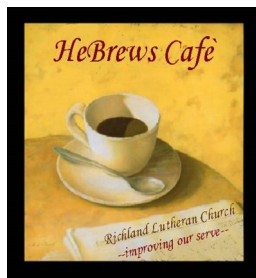
