Certain Unalienable Rights: Pursuit of Happiness From Pastor Steve, Lead Pastor



In the past few weeks, following Pastor Corey's resignation, I've heard from many of you and am thankful for it. Truly, I have been overwhelmed with the love and support which has been poured out among you for me personally and for our church. The myriad cards, calls, texts, emails, letters, direct conversations (masked and socially distanced of course), carrier pigeons (okay, not too many of these), and the rest have sustained me in this difficult time. Every communication, without exception, has voiced support and encouragement as we move together into the future God has ordained for us. Furthermore, most have asked about what's next and I'd like to get to that in this month's newsletter article.

Pastor Corey, as Associate Pastor, fulfilled two primary roles at Richland Lutheran Church since October 2015: Ministry Lead in the areas of worship and Christian service and Contemporary Music Leader. He dedicated roughly about half of his time to each of these roles. Knowing we can never truly replace Pastor Corey and the difficultly it would be to find someone who functions well in both of these roles, the Congregation Council and I have decided to separate these positions.

Please pray for the Staffing Committee as they look at our current staffing needs. I am in the process of putting together a Contemporary Music Coordinator Search Team, to include some Praise Team members, contemporary worship participants and Council members to look for someone who will lead this area of ministry for us at RLC. This position is virtually identical (except contemporary) to our Traditional Music Coordinator filled by Susie Nunamaker, and what a great job Susie does! I am confident we will find an equally competent contemporary coordinator. The Council has approved a job description and the search team will get to work in the next couple of weeks. In the interim, Susie Nunamaker has agreed to play our contemporary songs and use the vocalists from the Praise Team to help lead. Last week we enjoyed Susie and Jessica Schumaker. I am looking forward to enjoying more from them, and others, in the weeks to come.

Whenever there is a new staff vacancy, the Congregation Council activates the Staffing Committee to look deeper into the needs of the congregation at the time. They don't automatically assume the current staffing configuration is what is needed, but rather does due diligence to determine current staffing needs. The Congregation Council is in the process of activating this team and will depend on a recommendation from them regarding the other primary role Pastor Corey filled as Ministry Lead in the areas of worship and Christian service. In the interim, Amanda Daniels and Kelly Westlund, along with our other staff will fill in the gaps. What a blessing it is to have such a capable and willing staff!

Please allow me to use the words of the Apostle Paul to express my thoughts and feelings about future staffing and ministry at RLC, I am "confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus." There is no doubt in my mind, God is diligently working well ahead of us. This is just God's way. Please commit to be in prayer with me and the leadership of RLC as we seek God's appointed and anointed future for us. He has always been and will forever be faithful to Richland Lutheran Church.

Special Congregation Meeting - Retreat Center Funds Allocation

RLC's Council has scheduled a Special Congregational Meeting for September 20, 2020 at 12:30 PM for the long-awaited Retreat Center Fund Allocation vote. As of this writing the venue is expected to be virtual (Zoom/Webinar). You will receive more information as we move forward in the planning of this event. In the meantime, be sure to place the date and time on your calendars.

The Retreat Center Fund Committee made the following recommendations to RLC's Council and Congregation several months ago. The Council and the Staff support these recommendations.

Retreat Center Fund Team – Allocation of the remaining funds from the Offsite Retreat Center

The Committee agreed that uses that provided a service to Richland Lutheran Church members or the community and which could make a positive difference in their lives and relationship with God met the original intent of Retreat Center contributions.

The Committee's specific recommendations are Good News Media Ministry 10%, Urgent Assistance Funds 2%, RLC Foundation 16%, Mission Efforts (Estonia travel, Lodge Grass, etc.) 5%, Retreat Support (subsidizing individual retreats where needed) 5%, Food Pantry 2%, Spiritual Growth Events (Gedde Lectures, Renovare, speakers, etc.) 5%, RLC Facility Life Extension Fund 27%, and RLC Chapel Improvements (Soundproofing, new seating, audio/visual capability, etc.) 28% (NOTE: The current total amount is \$102,502. However, due to the daily change of the fund's dollar amounts, as originally published, the team was requested to convert the dollars to percentages.)

Our support is based on the following rationale:

- The Congregation has voted to not proceed with an Off-Site Retreat Center but use the church's facilities or available third-party retreat centers.
- The remaining funds from the sale of the property originally purchased for a retreat center has been reviewed by our Accounting Firm and been judged to not require approval from the original donors to repurpose the funds.
- The recommended usage of these funds is all for either:

Ministries that support spiritual growth, or Meet the needs of those in our community, or

Facility maintenance and upgrades to support our current ministries.

Ask Yourself... What would Jesus want me to do?



This is a one way drive-thru event!

Please enter **only** from the north entrance at the Van Giesen end of Kimball. Proceed south through the parking lot, then turning west through the back parking lot and exiting only to Stevens. (Please note the south Kimball driveway will not be used for either entering or exiting).
