### Planning for the Future of RLC: The Ministry and Mission Planning Team From Pastor Steve

Since the fall of 2022, Richland Lutheran Church (RLC) has had a team of folks working together on a strategic visioning team, the Ministry and Mission Planning Team (M & M), assembled and chartered by the Congregation Council. This team's purpose is to "Develop a strategic plan (or Guide and Vision) to accomplish the ongoing ministry and mission of RLC 'To make disciples who worship, grow, serve and steward."

For the past months, the team has been working diligently to: 1) determine what God is doing already with us, 2) discern where God is headed and leading us, and 3) define the strengths, gifts and competencies of our congregation, to develop a flexible plan for our future. Some of this has been done through book study together. We've read and discussed *Growing Young: Six Essential Strategies to Help Young People Discover and Love Your Church* and *The Church Revitalization Checklist: A Hopeful and Practical Guide for Leading Your Congregation to a Brighter Tomorrow.* Other ways we've been doing this work have been through, the practice of spiritual formation habits, demographic studies, identifying church trends and best practices, and periodical reviews, to a few. Namely, however, we have been rooted in God's Word and prayer, asking him to speak to and lead us.

Currently, we are in our last steps to put together a new "Guide and Vision," plan, or whatever God leads us to, by discussing and working through seven important questions for our congregation as we move forward into God's future. Though they may not make perfect sense without broader context, they are listed on page 5.

Our hope is to be able to present to you this "Guide and Vision" for our ministry and mission for the next 10, or so, years at our Annual Congregational meeting at the end of October. Once accepted and approved by you, we will begin to discuss what it will take to implement the Guide and Vision regarding resources to include staffing, facilities, finances and the rest.

We have been and continue to invite you to share with us how God is speaking to you these days about our ministry and mission. Last fall, we did a "prayer night" on Wednesday evenings where we provided time, space, and resources for you to communicate with us directly. All along, our team has been purposeful in listening to those with whom we interact and will continue to do this. And, we encourage you to contact our team directly through Amanda Daniels if you have input, questions, epiphanies, concerns, or anything else you'd like to share. Without you, this plan won't be what it needs to be to succeed. We are grateful for our partnership together in the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Mostly, we covet your prayers for us.

### President's Message: God is Faithful!

"The demand to know where we are going is one which no Christian has a right to make." These words, taken from a devotional reading entitled "Where God is Taking Us", were spoken at a 20th century synod meeting. It went on to read that Bishop Lesslie Newbigin, a British theologian who served as a missionary in India for many years, wrote in response - "In a very real sense we do not know where we are going, but we are trying to meet day by day the plain requirements of God's will. This means a constant effort to bring every part of church life and practice to the test of conformity with the Gospel." In other words, it's not for us to know God's plan; it's simply for us to follow our Shepherd and trust that He will faithfully provide for our needs – "even through the darkest shadows".

I mentioned RLC's Facilities Strategic Plan (adopted 2016) in last month's Preview, along with our barely-limping-along HVAC system, both of which need some serious TLC. Well, the time has now come for us to do something. For the last few months, Council has been in prayerful discussion and consideration regarding these two items, preparing our recommendations to bring to you for your consideration. As Pastor Steve announced (also in last month's Preview), Council is calling a Special Congregational meeting for August 27, for which these will be the only two items on the agenda. Here is some information to help you begin your preparation for this very important meeting.

Let's begin with **RLC's Facilities Strategic Plan**, which was adopted by the congregation in November 2016 with the intent to rebuild. Preliminary implementation of the Plan began with the formation of a fundraising committee to help initiate funding and the creation of two budget accounts, including the Cornerstone/capital fund. The fundraising committee was placed on hold until such time that we were able to discern God's plan for RLC and, although the Cornerstone fund does continue to grow, it does so very, very slowly as labor and material costs rapidly rise. We also removed the houses located on our adjacent properties and extended the parking lot, both needing to happen anyway. Then COVID paid us an unexpected and unwelcomed visit, placing a hold on everything. We now have before us two options which are: 1) resume implementation of the Plan knowing this would place an extreme financial burden on RLC **or** 2) retire the Plan and surrender ourselves to God allowing any future plans to be driven by our ministry and mission needs as they arise.

Our ministry needs here at RLC have changed significantly since adoption of this Plan and, as I know you will agree, our ministry needs should always drive any plan. Therefore, after much prayerful discussion and consideration, Council will be presenting to you our recommendation to: 1) retire RLC's Facilities Strategic Plan, 2) repurpose the Facilities Fundraising Committee, and 3) retain and continue to grow our Cornerstone/capital fund for future capital expenditures. I would like to add that with COVID's unexpected interruption to our lives, followed with the now significant cost increase in labor and materials, we're very blessed that we didn't find ourselves in the midst of implementation of this Plan. God continues to watch over us.

This brings me to our **HVAC system**, which is aged and has been in constant repair and continuing costs needing to be upgraded or replaced - soon. This, of course, would be a capital expenditure. I, again, thank those of you who have been



We will also host a one-night session on Surviving the Holidays on Wednesday, November 1, from 6-8 PM over Zoom.


