

Whereas Advent, Christmas, and Epiphany lead the believer into a joyful anticipation and remembrance of Jesus' birth and life, Lent leads the believer into a place of contemplation, meditation, and sober remembrance of the death and resurrection of Jesus. Often times believers fast, give something up, or abstain from the fineries of life. And/or enter into a more meaning time of spiritual formation. These practices help the believer enter deeply into knowing the curse of sin, the brokenness of the world, and the need for a savior.

I hope you will join me and the rest of Richland Lutheran Church as we intentionally get Lenty. One of the ways we'll do this is by gathering on Wednesday evenings for Soup Supper and Lent Worship. We eat a modest meal of soup together to enter into deeper intimacy with Jesus by cutting out the "fat!" as it were. Then we'll gather together in the Sanctuary for contemplative, experiential worship. For many, Lent Wednesdays have become one of the highlights of the liturgical year. They are a great way to deliberately practice remembering the cost Christ paid for our sins.

Our sermon series for Lent Wednesday's, arranged by Pastor Dave Hogan, is entitled, *Solving the Cross-Words Puzzle*. In this series, we will work our way through what's known as, "The 7 Last Words of Jesus." Really more sayings than words, these are the 7 last utterances of a dying Jesus on the cross. So come on Yall, get Lenty!

Romans 15:1

We who are powerful need to be patient with the weakness of those who don't have power, and not please ourselves. (CEB – Common English Bible)

God, in his providence, recently gave me this verse to ruminate upon. I say in his providence, because I had an experience in January which took me back to a time in my life which was very painful and confusing.

The experience I referred to above occurred when my friend Margie and I attended a retirement party for a lawyer friend. We seated ourselves at a back table so we could leave early in case the tributes became too long to stay – you know, lawyers talk a lot.

Two other couples around our age and who knew us came to sit next to us. And a little while later another couple, who were in their 30's came and sat down. The man of the younger couple seemed out of sorts, but his wife was lovely and gracious. The husband got up and left several times. Margie and I struck up a nice conversation with his wife, Anna, when he left our table. Over the course of the evening his departures lasted longer. And his behavior became stranger. Suddenly, it occurred to me that this was a familiar scene. Years earlier, one of my close friends was addicted to many things and would frequently leave without explanation, too.

It was around 9 PM when Margie and I decided to leave. More lawyers were slated to give tributes and we were tired. By then, Anna's husband had been gone for more than a half hour. She was quietly brushing away tears. When Margie and I left the event for the lobby of the venue I asked her if we should see if Anna needed a ride home. Margie agreed, and I went back to get Anna.

I returned to our table and asked her if she needed a ride to somewhere safe. She said she would very much like a ride. When we returned to the lobby, I said "I have a friend who is a drug addict, I know what you are going through. Where can we take you that is safe?" She cried and confirmed that he was an addict. She mentioned that he has been through rehab at least twice and that she was surprised that today was the day he fell off again.

When we reached the address she gave us, her husband was outside waiting for her. I asked her to tell us the truth – "is this a safe place for you?" She said, "Yes, he is not a violent person." What she doesn't know is the damage he is causing her; the bruises he is inflicting on her heart and soul.

I told her that she is smart, kind and beautiful. And, that I know he can't help what he is doing. What I didn't say is the truth that I finally learned which is you cannot love him out of it. That's God's job.

Why do I think this verse ties to this experience?

We can be angry at those who are addicted, but honestly, they are weak. They do not have power over this addiction and while in it, they cannot reach, or see, or even think about God. They cannot access Jesus' power to overcome. It is up to those of us who care about them and who are not afflicted to pray for their healing. They need a miracle of faith and healing.

Who do you know that is in a similar bondage? Take a moment each day to pray for them and their loved ones. They are all suffering and in bondage to the addictions.

Praying for your loved ones is a blessing and a gift you can give them.

I have appreciated you as friend, supervisor and pastor all these years and trust our friendship will continue.


