President's Message: Serving Our Lord First

"Whatever your task, put yourselves into it, as done for the Lord and not for your masters, since you know that from the Lord you will receive the inheritance as your reward; you serve the Lord Christ." Colossians 3:23-24

Here we are - half way through yet another year! How quickly time flies when we're having fun and, of course, we **are** having fun. We serve our Lord Jesus Christ first and, in serving Him, we serve all of you.

This has been a very busy year and a very busy Council, so I'd like to first extend to each one of my fellow Council members my heartfelt thanks and deep appreciation. To you all I say, "Well done good and faithful servant(s)." And, I thank you, the Congregation, for your prayers and your love and support. So – here's what we've been up to:

- We've formed and staffed two new and very important teams and I'd like to give a resounding "THANK YOU!" to all who accepted our invitation to serve on these teams.
 - The Good News Today Media Task Force was formed for the purpose of providing necessary and valuable information to Council regarding our Good News Today TV program to help us make an informed decision for the spreading of God's Word both near and long term. (See Pastor Steve's April Preview article.)
 - **RLC's Church Safety and Security Ministry Team's** purpose is to help assure RLC is a welcoming, safe and secure place to make disciples who worship, grow, serve and steward. This team's primary responsibility will be to manage and minimize risk and liability by the prevention of incidents on RLC property.
- We, once again, have a vacancy on our Nominating Committee due to a resignation. Since the Committee is now well into their selection process, Council made the decision to allow them to complete their work for this year with an empty seat. We will, however, be looking for someone to fill that vacancy for the remainder of the term (2024), along with identifying three more candidates for the regular twoyear term (2024-2025). We covet your prayers as we begin our search and we ask for prayers for the Nominating Committee as they continue their search for RLC's congregation leaders for the next two years.
- You are all aware by now that the parsonage stands vacant. Pastor Steve and Ginnette have become "happy" homeowners and the family has moved out of the parsonage into their new home. We offer them our congratulations, best wishes and,


