If you do, they may trample them under their feet, and turn and tear you to pieces.*" Both are sayings of Jesus and arguably equally important but, come on man!

The fall sermon series we've put together is a series I'm very excited about. Worship is one of my great passions, especially liturgical corporate worship. Please join us this fall on Sundays as we delve into a biblical study of worship. Some of the topics we'll dive into include worship form versus content, worship music, confession and absolution, passing of the peace, praise and proclamation, scripture reading, the sermon, creeds, corporate prayer, sacraments, and benediction. I'm looking forward to how Holy Spirit will use God's words regarding worship to continue to shape us into the image of Christ.

From the Council - Grow Your Faith: An Experiment Glenn Edgemon, Member At Large



As a materials and corrosion engineer with a love of laboratory testing, I’ve had a relatively unique professional career over the last 30 years. I’ve had the opportunity to design dozens of corrosion programs, travel to exotic locations (like Houston and Oakland) for field investigations, and write up hundreds of corrosion tests and infrastructure assessments. Recently, outside of work, I launched a new test program on my Christian faith, specifically – how to grow it.

To be clear, I did not have any plans to launch this new program. You could say it just kind of found me. After 50+ years of essentially attending Sunday services (and that’s about all), I found myself stuck in a bit of a rut, pondering more and more each year what I was doing.

About that same time, an opportunity came knocking: I was asked to join the church council. At first, I quite naturally assumed I’d misunderstood and they were asking someone behind me - but no, the invitation was for me. So, I decided to take the leap of faith and see where it took me. I am nothing if not pragmatic. I initially said “yes” to this opportunity strictly to see if I could be of more use to our church, but then I realized I’d also launched an experiment – could the church and my faith become more useful to me?

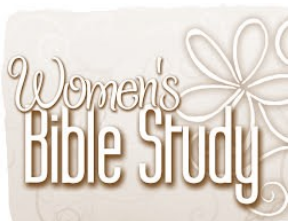
I’m about halfway through my first year on council, or as I sometimes think of it, halfway through the first year of my accidental test program. If you’re still reading, you may be wondering - so how it’s going? Well, in a nutshell, it’s working! I’m certainly out of that spiritual rut, often entirely out of my comfort zone (usually a good sign for growth of any kind), and more involved in a church than I’ve ever been. I’ve improved existing relationships, developed new ones, learned a bit on how the church operates, enjoyed the rewards of volunteering m7 time, and to my surprise, found a sense of growth in my faith.

So – why am I sharing this with you? Mostly I want to reach you if you’re stuck in your own spiritual rut. Has the endless stream of bad news on the internet and television sapped your spirit? Are you having trouble getting motivated to attend worship? Are you feeling like your faith has stagnated? Are you feeling like your prayers have been pretty one-sided lately? Well – if so, take heart, there’s good news! If you are willing to stretch yourself just a little, serve the Lord and help the church, I think you will find much spiritual reward. Even better news – many of these opportunities are right in front of you and within easy reach. Some may even come and find you! You could commit to greeting one new person each Sunday, or join a committee, attend a function, join a Sunday school class, or support one of numerous other opportunities to serve. No matter what, I think you’ll find it to be good for your faith and good for those around you too.

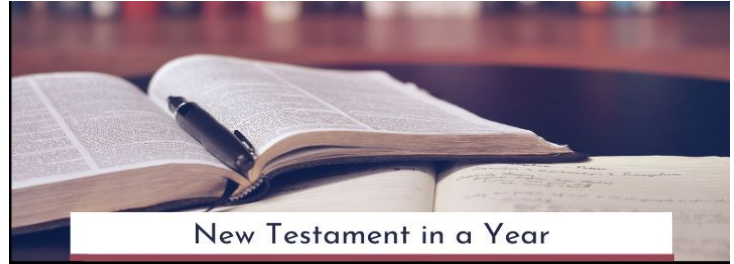

HOW TO...Mark Your Unavailability Calendar for Worship Assistant Scheduling



- Log in to the church online portal, Church Community Builder (CCB)
- Click on your profile page by clicking the circle monogram in the top right hand corner menu bar.
- Click “involvement” in the menu bar centered under the blue-gradient banner towards the top of the page.
- Locate the “Serving” box and hover your mouse over the top right corner of the box until the “...” appears. A short pop up menu will appear. Click “Mange Serving”
- You can now see all of the serving opportunities you (and others in your household) have been scheduled for!
 - By hovering over the right hand side of each opportunity, you can select “accept” or “decline”.
 - By clicking “Browse Open Positions” in the upper menu bar, you can find other future opportunities that have not yet been scheduled for the teams you are associated with.
- Click the gear-icon in the top right corner to block out dates of unavailability, and to change availability preferences.
 - By clicking the triangle near your name, you can toggle between household members to adjust everyone’s preferences and availability.
- When done, click “close” to return to the “manage serving” page.

And personal care items: Toothbrushes (no toothpaste), wide-tooth combs, hair accessories, adhesive bandages (i.e. band aids®), non-liquid lip balm, nail clippers, nail files, compact mirrors, stick deodorant.

This is also a great time to start writing notes to be included in the boxes! A simple handwritten note, even on just plain stationary or notebook paper, letting the recipient know that Jesus loves them, will go a long way in making the box more personal.
